EXPANSION JOINTS

July Meeting

Programs Committee

This month's evening meeting will be on the topic of "long holes," a.k.a expansion joints. Presentation will cover building envelope expansion joint closure systems - types and methods to transition successfully to provide continuity of seal. Movement capabilities and sizing considerations. This will include: tube, SMACNA, NRCA, formed and extruded metal; bellows, both extruded and fabricated, and compression seals. Fire, insulation, and sound barriers will also be illustrated.

Building envelopes today are becoming more critical to the overall performance of structure environments. Dynamic closure systems that provide a reliable performance sealing system for the expansion joints that will perform under many different conditions is required more now than ever. Successful integration of all dynamic components from the roofs to the walls and all substrates is required to meet the desired results.

This presentation will address the transitions and interfacing of multiple configurations that can be encountered going from roofs to walls and multiple way intersections. The use of secondary closures and insulated configurations plus fire rated assemblies will also be shown and how they interact. Problems and solutions will be shown. The benefits of detailing in 2D and 3D/Isometric will be shown how it leaves less to chance in critical areas. BIM environment information will also be covered.

Specifications and their role of being less generic and more focused on the specific needs and results will be covered addressing the pitfalls of broad spectrum vague information that creates challenges between areas and trades.

Understanding of this collective information will result in better specifications, drawings, and installation and better buildings. This information is personal experience over 25 years and working with most of the manufactures of expansion joint closure systems in the United States and working on jobs all over the world. Specification considerations along with BIM information will be presented. Credit will be (1) hour of HSW. The speakers will be our own David Dixon and Doug Pearmain.

If anyone can help locate all the pictures taken during the SpecSource days that would be a start.


